With the owner's permission, I took Steve home with me. He has spent his last lonely and desolate day at that abandoned house. But this sudden opportunity means we really need your help to find temporary foster care and a permanent loving home for this deserving boy. Steve is proving to be a sweet, gentle boy... My neighbor gave him an old dog bed, which he plopped onto immediately... he's had nothing but wet plastic for a bed.
